TOWN OF EASTEND Bylaw No. 613/03

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE SETTING OFF OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF EASTEND.

The Council of the Town of Eastend in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

That the setting off of Fireworks within the limits of the Town of Eastend is prohibited unless it is done so, in a manner, that the following regulations are adhered to:

- That prior written approval of the Council must be given to parties applying to set off said fireworks, including the date, time and place of the fireworks display.
- That the personnel setting off said fireworks must take the federally or provincially required courses beforehand and be properly licensed to set off said fireworks.
- That the Fire Chief, or his duly appointed deputy, and the Town of Eastend fire truck must be on duty and at the scene of the fireworks display.
- 4. That the Town of Eastend is in no way responsible for any injury or damage that may be caused by those who are setting off the fireworks display, either wilfully or otherwise.
- A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary of conviction to a fine of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00).

Bylaw 376/90 is hereby repealed.
