TOWN OF EASTEND BYLAW No. 755/2023

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE A WASTE & RECYCLING PROGRAM AS A PUBLIC UTILITY.

The Council of the Town of Eastend, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. Definitions:
 - (a) "Designated Property" means any property receiving water and sewer service.
- The Town of Eastend shall provide a Waste & Recycling program as a Public Utility service that shall be delivered by a subcontractor.
- 3. All designated properties are required to have waste and recycle carts, containers or commercial bins.
- 4. All residents and businesses shall adhere to the regulations of the subcontractor providing the Waste & Recycling service as per attached pamphlets on Form "A".
- 5. The Town of Eastend Waste & Recycling service shall occur on a set collection schedule and may be amended by the subcontractor from time to time.
- 6. The owner or occupant of a designated property shall ensure the containers assigned to that designated property are:
 - (a) stored in a location at the designated property that is under the care and control of the owner or occupant of that designated property;
 - (b) used to set out waste or recycling for the Town of Eastend Waste & Recycling service;
 - (c) to remain with that designated property;
 - (d) kept clean;
 - (e) maintained in good condition;
 - (f) not altered in any way;
 - (g) available to the Town of Eastend, it's contractors or agents, within a reasonable time for the purposes of inspection, maintenance or repair.
- 7. Carts used for Town of Eastend Waste & Recycling service:
 - (a) are not the property of the owner or occupant of the designated property;
 - (b) may be removed by the Town of Eastend, it's contractors or agents, at the direction of council.
- 8. No person shall scavenge waste from a cart, container, commercial bin or big blue bin.
- An owner or occupant shall only store and set out waste generated from the owner or occupant's designated property.
- 10. The Town of Eastend shall charge the rates set by the subcontractor. Form "B"
- 11. Accounts for waste and recycling fees shall cover a period of three (3) months and shall be invoiced on a quarterly basis with the Water & Sewer Utility billing. Such accounts shall be paid within thirty (30) days from the date the said account was rendered.
- 10. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties in the general penalty bylaw of the Town of Eastend.
- 11. Bylaw 738/20 is hereby repealed.
- 12. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect April 1, 2023
